I really rate this muzzle having bought 3 recently. My horse is a muzzledestroyer and managed to tear the strap that goes over the poll where it is sewn to the basket bit that goes over his nose after about 30 hours wear which was a little disappointing. I will try to get it repaired and have the sewing on the straps reinforced and the Velcro safety bit sewn up as he will get it off too easily otherwise. It is still safe as the parachute plastic clips will break if he ever gets it stuck on something. These are a great feature that set these muzzles apart from the competition in my opinion.

These muzzles rub much less than the other bucket type and fluffy bucket type ones he has, he has Shires, Hy and Roma and greenguard muzzles and possibly a few other brands.

Dinkys are the best muzzle on the market. I have tried all the other muzzles my local tack shop stocks and Dinky's Beat them. They do not come off easily as they come quite far up the nose, they have caused no rubs or issues with teeth and last quite long as my horse wears his muzzle from April/ May to November. I use several in rotation so he does not have to wear a wet one long.

He and his buddies are expert muzzle removers and wreckers and I went through about 8 bucket type muzzles with various adaptations before finding dinkys which stay on.

As a design improvement I would like to see a lead ring so I can lead him from the muzzle like other brands have, I also do not like the Velcro strip on the newer dinkys as I think the plastic clip will break for safety in an emergency so the Velcro is not required and once it is opened it gets dirty quickly and the muzzle does not stay on as well.

Within two months of wearing the muzzles for up to 12 hours per day, the holes underneath the muzzle are far too large and no longer restrict grazing enough. I do not feel that this is an adequate time scale and that you should reinforce the bottom of the muzzle so that it is more hard wearing. Otherwise I am going to need 3 muzzles per pony per grass growing season!!!

Unfortunately the design does not allow the pony to graze at all. It is good if you wish to restrict all intake but if you only wish to reduce intake it is not a good product. The fit was good but there is nowhere to attach a lead rope which means you have to put a head collar on top. I would not recommend this item.

An excellent lightweight and comfortable muzzle. It has stayed on so far, although I do secure it to the mane with a hairband. The only downside is the base of the muzzle is wearing through after only a couple of weeks.
